Retreat Cost: \$545

Price includes field trips, resourcing, housing, and meals. Canoes, kayaks, life-jackets, and paddles will be available during free time. Price also includes blankets, quilts, pillows and all local taxes. Linens are not provided but are available upon request at \$6/packet. (Packet includes: 1 set of sheets, pillow case, 1 bath towel and 1 wash cloth).

Accommodations: The log cabins are fully furnished housing units which accommodate 2-4 people comfortably. Each cabin has 1-3 bedrooms with varying sleeping accommodations (queen, double, etc.). The kitchen and sitting areas provide additional relaxation and reading spaces. Typically retreatants share cabins. Bedrooms that hold more than one bed may also be shared. Though we encourage participants to experience the full benefits of retreat, high-speed internet is available at our Pine Ridge location (4 miles away) if needed.

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Retreat Schedule

Join Bill Tefft in exploring the habitats of North Eastern Minnesota, including: lakes, forest/uplands, wetlands, altered environments and wilderness areas. Participants of past retreats lead by Bill have seen over 100 different species of birds, including the Connecticut Warbler. In addition to daily field trips, participants can expect morning and evening readings chosen from the writings of Wendell Berry, Mary Oliver, and other nature writers. There will be time for campfire conversations as well as free time to explore and play.

June 14, Day 1: Arrive between 3:30-5:30, settle into cabins.

Evening: Supper at 6:00pm, welcome, introductions, and orientation

June 15, Day 2: Birding/Field Trip/ Orientation to habitat and place.

Morning, 5:30: Breakfast

6:30: On site birding experience.

Mid morning -afternoon: Field trip with observation of local habitats and trip to Listening Point. Packed lunch in the field.

Evening: Supper on site, evening reading, canoe/kayak skills and free time to paddle.

June 16 and 17, Day 3&4: Birding field trip/ Ely exploration/free time

Morning, 5:30: Breakfast

6:30 - mid afternoon: Birding field trip. Packed lunch in field.

Evening: 16th- supper (on own in town), 17th - supper on site, evening reading and free time.

June 18, Day 5: Birding field trips/free time.

Morning, 5:30: Breakfast

6:30: Birding field trip. Lunch back on site with discussion about individual interests.

Afternoon: Optional Birding trip/free time.

Evening: Supper on site and closing ceremony.

June 19, Day 6: Day of Departure

Morning, 8:00: Breakfast

Departure (Participants are welcome to continue to use the cabin until 1:00pm. If you would like to stay longer (or arrive earlier), please make arrangements in advance. Additional nights cost \$35/per person.)
