Price includes: housing, meals, canoes, kayaks, lifejackets, paddles, possible day trip to Bass Lake Falls/Bear Head State Park, and all local taxes. Blankets, quilts, pillows are included. Linens are not provided but are available upon request at \$6/packet. (Packet includes: 1 set of sheets, pillow case, 1 bath towel and 1 wash cloth).

Accommodations: The log cabins are fully furnished housing units which accommodate 2-4 people comfortably. Each cabin has 1-3 bedrooms with varying sleeping accommodations (queen, double, etc.). The kitchen and sitting areas provide additional relaxation and reading spaces. Retreatants will share cabins. Bedrooms that hold more than one bed may also be shared.
